## Proper Student Attire/Behavior for Graduation

Parent/Guardian, please discuss and reinforce appropriate graduation ceremony attire and behavior with your child. **We will not allow** individuals to participate in the ceremony who intend to detract from the appropriate decorum by wearing inappropriate attire, being under the influence of chemicals, or by engaging in disruptive behavior. Suggested student attire:

1. Boys & Girls should wear nice shoes (No tennis shoes or flip flops).
2. Boys should wear a dress shirt and tie.
3. Boys should wear long dress pants (No shorts).
4. Boys **should not** wear a suit/sport coat under the robe (you will be too warm).
5. Girls should wear a dress, skirt, or long dress slacks (No shorts).
6. Students- no cell phones or electronic devices.

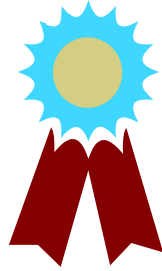
